

Quick Cleaning Checklist

FOR WHEN YOU DON'T KNOW WHERE TO START

01 5 min.

- Pray.
- Read a Bible verse about working diligently.
- Believe God will answer your prayer.

Always begin with a clean heart.

Start a load of laundry.

02 20 min.

- Wash all the dishes.
- Wipe down counters.
- Throw out old food in the refrigerator.
- Sweep and mop floors.
- Put away clutter.

Begin cleaning in the kitchen if it's messy.

03 15 min.

- Clean toilet first.
- Put away clutter.
- Wipe down sink, mirror, and window.
- Scrub out bathtub.
- Sweep and wash floor.

Next, move on to the bathrooms.

Switch the laundry.

06 15 min.

- Fold laundry and put it away.
- Start another load.
- Put away clutter you collected in laundry baskets from around the house.

Finally, let's finish what we started. Go get the fresh warm laundry out of the dryer, fold it, and put it away immediately. Then, put away any collected clutter.

05 35 min.

- Change sheets and make beds.
- Put all clutter into a laundry basket.
- Dust all surfaces.
- Sweep or vacuum floors.

Now you can move onto the bedrooms. We're doing a basic clean. Not deep cleaning.

04 30 min.

- Pick up all clutter and put in laundry basket.
- Fluff pillows.
- Dust all surfaces.
- Sweep or vacuum floors.

Next, move to the living areas and common areas. Use a basket to gather all clutter to disperse around the house later. Don't go back and forth across the house.

Grab a timer and set it for each of the times listed per step. Follow the cleaning workflow. This is time to work quickly. See how much you can get done before the timer goes off! With this method, you'll be done in two hours. Rest and reward yourself for a job well done.
